

Pileta Cave & Jimera

Cycling - 25km



This route uses a combination of roads and tracks to explore the limestone mountains to the west of Ronda. You will visit two of the caves formed by thousands of years of water pouring through the hillsides and enjoy fabulous views across miles of craggy limestone mountains. The climb to the Pileta cave is long but generally fairly steady and the final descent is long, fast, twisting and fun.

En route, we cycle along the Guadiaro River and visit the Cueva del Gato, "Cat Cave". This local beauty spot, with a small waterfall and beautiful pool of crystal clear water, it is the exit point of a 7km underground river. We then climb steadily up into the mountains to visit the Pileta Cave (optional tour, entry €8), where you can see prehistoric cave paintings and huge stalactites deep inside the mountain cave. Our final descent takes us down to the small hamlet of Jimera estacion.

Time: 4-5 hours (incl 1 hr Pileta cave tour)
Ascent: 487 metres
Descent: 792 metres
Max Alt: 704 metres
Start: Ronda
Finish: Jimera

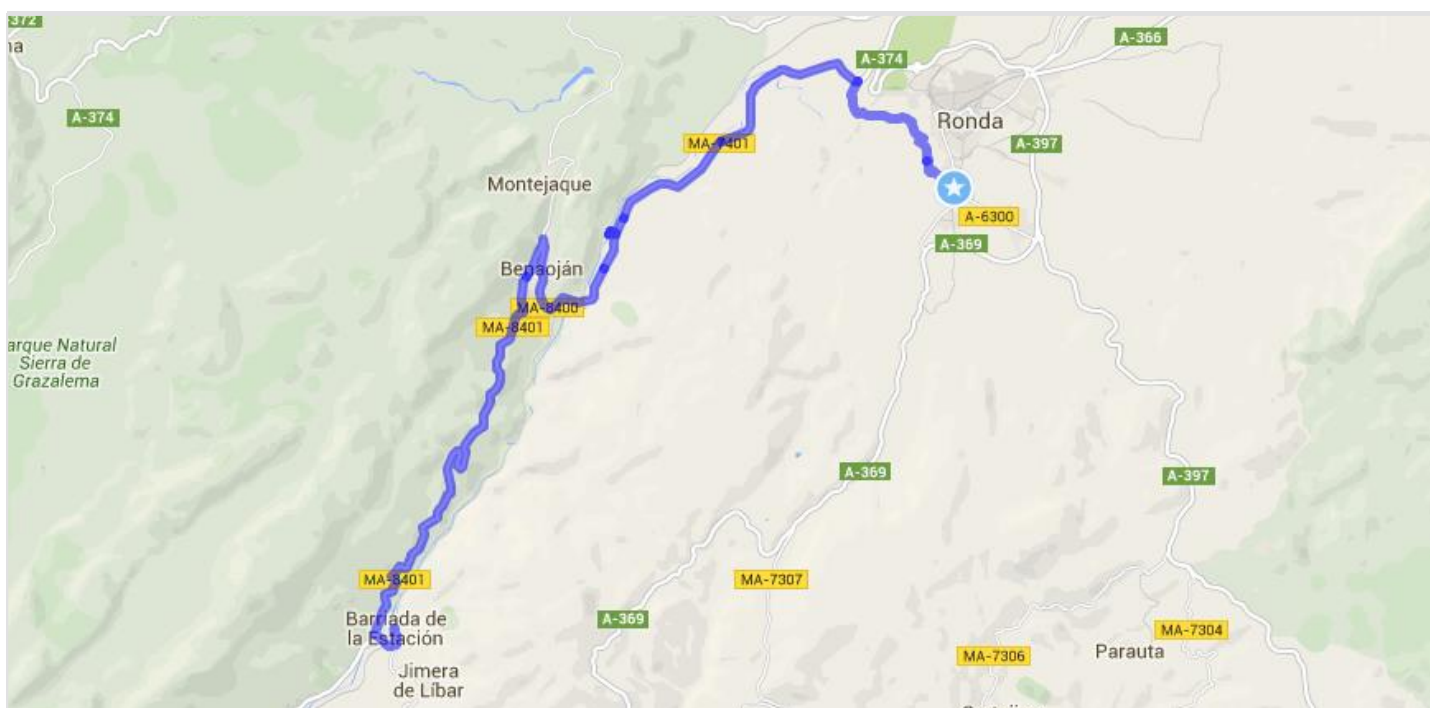

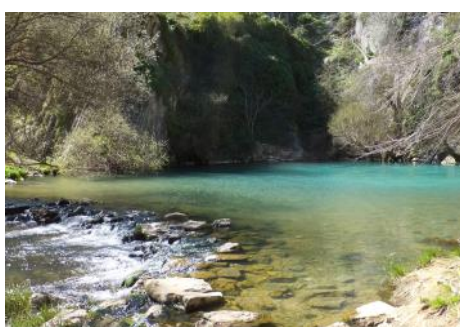
