

Tajo del Abanico and Cuevo del Gato

Walking - Moderate



This is an extended version of our short walk to the Tajo del Abanico which finishes in the Guadiaro valley to the West of Ronda.

We head out to the south, via the old Barrio San Francisco, and on to a viewpoint at the site of a former preacher's tower which gives a perfect view of Ronda, its bridge and the old and new towns to each side. You will be able to pick out major landmarks whilst marvelling at the precipitous position of the town on its sheer rock wall cliff. We then carry on to the Tajo del Abanico to marvel at this hidden limestone gorge unknown to many visitors of Ronda. From here we cross over the hills which tower over the Rio Guadiaro and we are treated to views of the forbidding mountains of the Grazalema Natural Park. Our final descent is into the river valley where we can walk along the Rio Guadiaro to the Cueva del Gato for a paddle in the fresh water that exits the cave from a waterfall. An alternative finish is to walk back along the river to Benaolan Estacion where you can have lunch at the Molino del Santo restaurant which serves excellent food in a beautiful location.

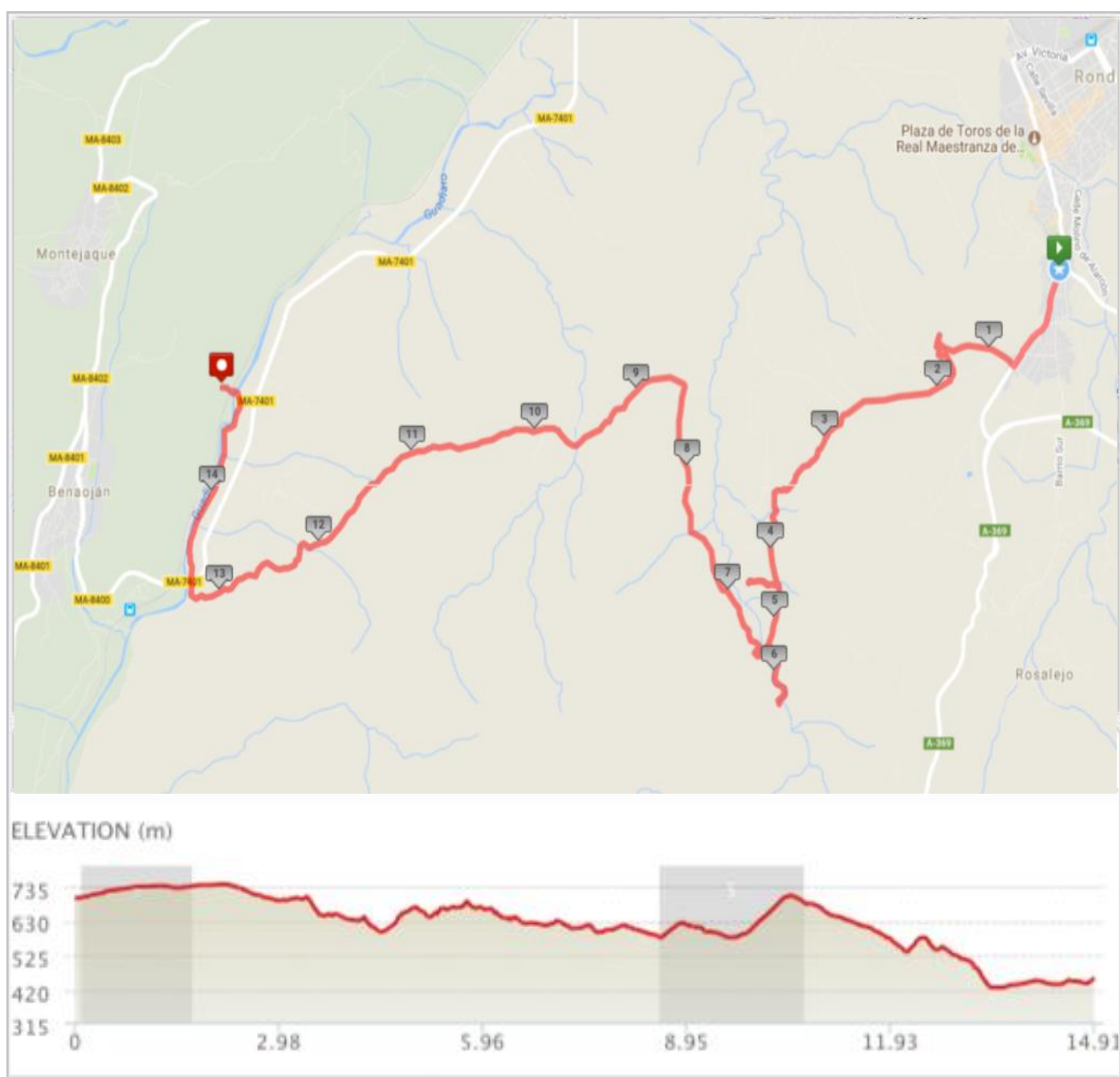
